


Which Caregiver Are You?

Family Caregivers of Adults

Nearly 40 million Americans provide unpaid care to an adult age 50 or older each year. In the spectrum of caregiver types, which one are you?



The Working Daughter

The average caregiver: a 49-year-old woman who works outside the home and provides 20 hours per week of unpaid care to her mother.



26% are also parents of a minor



>50% financially support an adult child



16% regularly take care of a grandchild

The Caring Man

The average age for a son caring for a parent or in-law is 46.4 years old. The average age of male caring for spouse/ partner is 62.5 years old.
